This program has been developed to enhance performance and build confidence and competence in a safe and confidential setting.

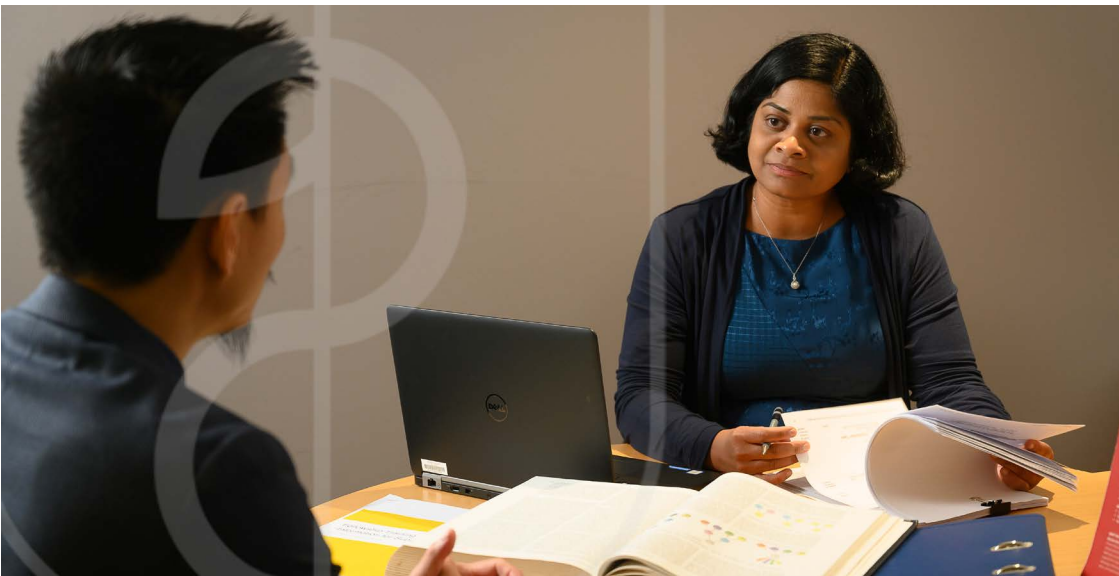
The Leadership for Clinicians program is delivered as both a blended program, including face to face and online sessions and fully online. More information can be found on the RACMA website.
